AJ Roberts-Draper,

Given the scope and magnitude of the issues addressed, the Postal Service respectfully requests that it be given the customary 15 days to file a response brief, and that other counsel for claimants in this matter also be given 15 days to file their response(s), if any. The Agency does not believe it could adequately address all issues raised within a deadline of forty-eight hours, and that such a deadline would be unfairly prejudicial to both the Postal Service and other counsel for claimants in this matter.

Additionally, the Postal Service requests the customary 15 days to file its response brief because I am lead counsel for the Agency and I am currently preparing for a three-week hearing in front of the Occupational Safety and Health Review Commission later this month which requires my full attention, including pretrial submissions due this week. As lead counsel for the Postal Service in these EEOC proceedings, it is critical that I have an opportunity to participate in this briefing and prepare for the status conference.

If it is your intention to address the issues raised in this motion and any response brief(s) during the February 14, 2019 conference call, the Postal Service respectfully requests that the call be postponed for 15 days to allow all parties to brief the issues presented prior to any discussion of those issues.

Please let me know as soon as possible whether the Postal Service may respond within the customary 15 days for response briefs and whether the February 14, 2019 conference call will be rescheduled so that the Postal Service and all interested participants may have a reasonable opportunity to consider and respond to the pending motion.
